Myringotomy / Tympanostomy (Ear tubes)

Ear drops – a prescription for ear drops has been sent to your pharmacy. Please have the prescription filled before the day of the surgery and bring the bottle – UNOPENED with you to the surgery center. Dr Walker will use the ear drops and give them back to you for use at home.

What to expect after surgery

- 1. Fussiness from the general anesthetic is normal.
- 2. A few drops of blood out of the ears in the first few days is normal.
- 3. If infection was present at the time of surgery, the ears may drain for several days.
- 4. There may be mild ear discomfort.

Post-op care

- 1. Recovery time for ear tubes is usually shortly following recovery from anesthesia.
- Use the ear drops given to you as directed. In most cases, Dr Walker prefers 3 drops in the treated ear 3 times per day for the next 5 days. Warm the ear drops between the hands for 1-2 minutes prior to application, to bring the drops to room temperature to avoid dizziness. DO NOT store the drop in the refrigerator.
- 3. Tylenol or ibuprofen may be used as needed for pain.
- 4. Dr Walker will see the patient back approximately 2 weeks after surgery, and then every six months until the tubes are out and the eardrum is healed.

Water precautions

- 1. Bathing and showering do not require any special precautions.
- 2. Patients with ear tubes may swim in chlorinated water no deeper than 15 feet without the use of ear plugs.
- **3.** Dr Walker recommends that the patient use antibiotic ear drops at bedtime on the day the patient has gone swimming.
- 4. Ear plugs should be worn if the patient swims in a lake, pond, river or ocean.
- **5.** Antibiotic drops should be used at bed time if the patient swims in a lake, pond, river or ocean.

<u>Please call the office if the following occurs</u>

- 1. Fever of greater than 101 degrees.
- **2.** Large amounts of pus is draining from the ear after 5 days of ear drop treatments.

If there are continued problems after three weeks, contact our office to make a follow-up appointment.
